Improvement Planning Process

This is Branch Line School's first year of operation. An invitation went out to the Branch Line community asking for volunteers to be on the School Improvement Team but no volunteers stepped forward. Because of the lack of volunteers, the instructional leads approached various stakeholders that met with teachers often about concerns with the academic program at the school. Formal meetings were not scheduled this year but instead the stakeholders controlled when they were able to meet to discuss student outcomes and the academic program.

For the 2014-15 school year the School Improvement Team will meet after each report card marking. Meeting after the report cards have been completed will allow the team to discuss data and what trends they have seen during the card marking. This will allow changes to be implemented immediately. An invitation will go out again asking for volunteers for the team. If there are no volunteers the Instructional Lead will approach one parent from each cohort to participate on the team. The meetings will be scheduled with the stakeholders to be sure that all can attend. A call in number will be available for those who are unable to attend in person.

There was a representative from each cohort in the school that assisted in the development of the improvement plan. The representative met with their teacher and discussed the academic program on a regular basis.
